It included a magnificent programme of visits, as well as an individual blind tasting competition to identify grape varieties and a collective rating of the 25 wines served during the meals.

. The 3rd « F.I.C.B. sponsored wine discovery tour » is organized in 2025 by the Order of the Knights of the Truffle and the Wines of Alba in the region of Langhe-Roero in the Piemonte (Italy) from 22 to 26 May 2025

. The Illustrious Order of the Knights of Medusa has decided to withdraw from organizing the F.I.C.B. 53rd International Congress in the Provence and Côte d'Azur region, following internal difficulties. The F.I.C.B. executive committee expressed its surprise and disappointment. It instructed the F.I.C.B. team to seek an alternative solution and to report back to the 2025 General Assembly.

A number of anniversaries are celebrated in 2024 :

. The 70th anniversary of the Conseil des Echansons de France, celebrated on 11 October at the Eglise Sainte-Clotilde in Paris with a mass followed by a banquet attended by over 150 guests.

. The Commende Majeure du Roussillon celebrated its 60th anniversary at a symposium in Perpignan at the end of May. This brotherhood also celebrated the 650th anniversary of the creation

of the medieval brotherhood of which it is the heir.

. The 40th of the creation of the Ordo Equestris Vini Europae, celebrated in Eisenstadt (Austria) on 19 October.

. The 30th for the Confrérie de Saint-Romain en Bordelais et Pays Libournais, celebrated in Fronsac on 24-25 February.

. The 20th for the Brotherhood of the Slovenian Wine Knights (Z.R.S.V.V.), celebrated on 19 October.

. the F.I.C.B. wished all a happy anniversary with special messages, and will itself be celebrating the 60 years of its own creation at the 2025 General Assembly.

F.I.C.B. Diplomas of Honour

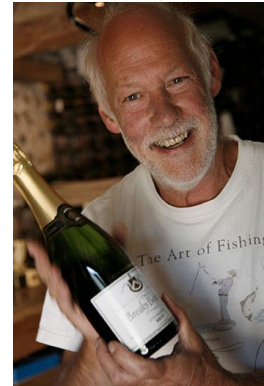
. We have published and posted online a brochure presenting the personalities who have received our Diploma of Honour since 2015.
